People always ask: "How is it possible that bichons need to be rescued? Aren't they expensive, well-loved pets? Sadly there are far more dogs of all kinds needing to be rescued than homes and families to love them! Bichons coming in to rescue now are just now more visible than in previous years - and there are greater numbers of them in need.

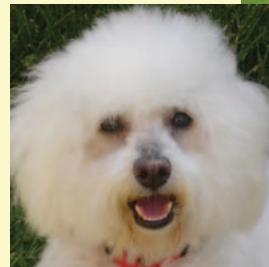
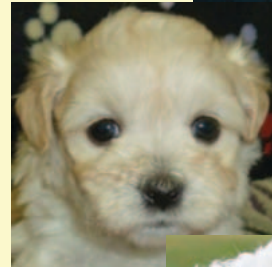
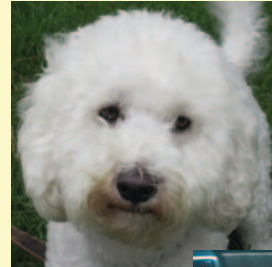
Whether due to a move, a death in the family, or just ending up as a stray in a shelter, they come to us - week in and week out. **We do our best, with your help**, to keep up with the increasing need. And we KNOW we can place all of them in Forever Homes, once we get them to foster care.

**Each of us does what we can** - some volunteers conduct home safety checks for families who want to adopt, others transport supplies, and some drive furkids to wherever they need to go. We also have - and always need - loving families to foster our furkids in transition.

Fostering is a critical part of what we do - as **we can only save as many dogs as we have foster homes**. Bichon FurKids pays for the medical expenses and supplies associated with fostering - and we ask our volunteers to provide the love and training.

The biggest concern we usually hear regarding fostering is "How will I ever be able to love a dog, then give it away?" That is a challenge, although when you help to choose the family that becomes his or her Forever Family there is a deep sense of satisfaction. And when you are not able to let them go, we call that "flunking fostering." When Max joined our family I officially flunked fostering for the third time. (Trust me, I had no intention of ever having three bichons... but I now think that three is the perfect number!)

After you successfully register your card online, you will see organization information for Bichon FurKids Rescue on your profile page. Please print this page and keep it for your records.

Individual purchases begin counting towards Bichon FurKids Rescue within 72 hours of registering your rewards card on-line. Every time you shop



for groceries and swipe your card, Bichon FurKids Rescue automatically starts earning a rebate. Just look on your receipt and you will see 'At your Request, Ralphs is donating to Bichon FurKids Rescue' within 7 business days of online registration.

Donations are made on almost everything, every time you shop! However, there are specific items that cannot be included such as purchases of alcohol, tobacco, pharmacy, postage stamps, gift cards, gift certificates, lottery and promotional tickets, fluid milk and milk products, fuel, CRV and Sales Tax.

For those of you who are already participating in the program - It's that time again!!!

Each September the Program requires we re-register our Ralphs Club Card. You must re-register every year. Those of you who already participate help us save more FurKids each and every time you shop at Ralphs! Every time you use your Club card, Ralphs will automatically donate up to 4% of your purchase to Bichon FurKids Rescue!
